Club Demonstrations

All club members will need to give a demonstration at one of the club meetings. The demonstration should only be 4 to 5 minutes long and something you like or is fun. It is NOT to be stressful. Examples of demos: your rabbit breed, dribbling a basketball, dance, a rock collection.....something you know and is fun.

Sign up dates will be available at the first few meetings, and if you do not sign up a date will we picked for you.

Animal Project Books

If you are new you need a rabbit learning project book. Each family should have a rabbit resource book. If you did a rabbit project last year, you can continue with the project book/s you started. In addition you will need the rabbit record insert. We will explain the books and show examples at the meeting.

As always we have clover bud rabbit projects books.

Rabbit Quality Assurance

Quality Assurance **IS** required for Meat Pen, Roaster and Single Fryer Rabbit Projects. However, this training is good for all since we must use healthy and drug free practices for our rabbits.

If you are taking any other market animal to the fair besides rabbits you must attend one quality assurance session. Classes are listed in the county 4-H newsletter, and the 2023 Van Wert County 4-H Family Guide.
