4-H online is new and improved for 2025! Though the layout has changed, most of features are still the same. It is also more mobile friendly – so it is easier to access on a mobile phone or smaller tablet.

The county deadline for enrollment is April 1, 2025! Please use the steps below to complete your enrollment.

To enroll in a 4H club you need to go online. It takes about 5 minutes if all goes correctly. If you forgot your password from last year there is a place to re-set a new one.

#1 on facebook go to Van Wert County 4H.....scroll down to 4-H online enrollemnt 2025 (note there is new information on 4H every week.)

#2 go to your app. Store and download Van Wert County 4H (note there is new information on 4H every week.)

#3 in your web browser go to **oh.4honline.com**

If you or another of your family members are already in the program or have been in recent years – please do not create a new profile. ...If you have problems, contact the 4H office and they can help with log in. (419-238-1214)

Animal Project Books

If you are new you need a rabbit learning project book. Each family should have a rabbit resource book. If you did a rabbit project last year, you can continue with the project book/s you started. In addition you will need the rabbit record insert. We will explain the books and show examples at the meeting.

Rabbit Quality Assurance

Quality Assurance **IS** required for Meat Pen, Roaster, and Single Fryer Rabbit Projects. However, this training is good for all since we must use healthy and drug free practices for our rabbits.

If you are taking any other market animal to the fair besides rabbits you must attend one quality assurance session. Classes are listed in the county 4-H newsletter, and the 2025 Van Wert County 4-H Family Guide.
