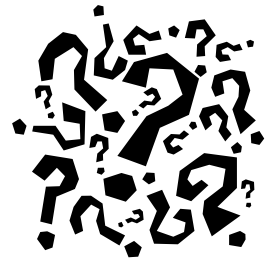
## A Busy Summer is Coming

## Let's Clarify Rabbit Animal Projects



**NEW THIS YEAR:** YOU MUST TAKE BREEDING RABBITS #225 TO TAKE MARKETS RABBITS #226. (That means you must complete a breeding rabbit project and show at the county fair junior rabbit show, to show and sell a meat pen or single fryer at the auction).

Also to be eligible for the special \$20.00 award for a doe and litter, the project must be an "A" grade. This means the litter must the correct number of animals, correct age, and no babies added that are not a part of that original litter. Also you probably will need to present the doe and litter on the show table instead of judging in the cage.
